## PRESIDIO PARKWAY PROJECT OVERVIEW

Passing through National Park lands, the new Presidio Parkway will be a spectacular gateway to San Francisco and the Golden Gate Bridge, to be completed in 2015.

## PROJECT ELEMENTS

- 2 – 3 large drill rigs and support equipment will be seen and heard during work hours.
- Flaggers and signs will assist visitors when vehicles cross public paths or for temporary restrictions.
- Work areas will be clearly marked with cones and barriers.
- Parking will not be affected.

Geotechnical exploration with drilling and boring equipment, along with marine surveys with a barge-mounted drill will be used to determine the design for replacing an existing storm drain that crosses Crissy Field.

A wildlife biologist and an archaeologist will be on site to protect National Park natural and cultural resources.
