Media Opportunities during the Extended Weekend Closure of Doyle Drive, July 9 to July 13

WHAT: During the extended weekend closure of Doyle Drive, July 9 to July 13, the project team will host a series of media events, including daily briefings and site visits, to keep the media and public apprised of construction progress in anticipation of the roadway opening.

A media center will be available on Friday, July 10 and Sunday, July 12 at the Observation Post, 211 Lincoln Boulevard, and will include work space, WiFi, project images and project materials. The media center will be in close proximity to the primary construction areas during the weekend closure.
