UPDATE: RESTORATION WORK ALONG LYON STREET AND RICHARDSON AVENUE

Intermittent lane closures along Highway 101, late September through October

Beginning in late September and continuing through early November, restoration and striping work is expected at the Gorgas Avenue/Richardson Avenue intersection.

Beginning Monday, October 10, for approximately three days, crews are scheduled to off-haul materials and place soils in preparation for final landscaping at the former bus stop near the Palace of Fine Arts. Lane closures along northbound Highway 101 at the Lyon Street intersection are expected to support this work.

Subsequently, beginning Thursday, October 13, lane closures are scheduled along southbound Highway 101 at the Gorgas Avenue/Richardson Avenue intersection for crews to off-haul materials and place soils behind the YMCA Pool (Building 1151).

To minimize impacts to residents, weekday lane closures are scheduled for the daytime hours when traffic volumes are lowest. Restoration work behind the YMCA Pool is expected to continue into mid-October.

In early November, crews are scheduled to install permanent bollards and final signage and striping for the completion of the Gorgas Avenue/Lyon Street pedestrian and bicycle corridor.
