### STONE COLUMN INSTALLATION NORTH OF MAIN POST TUNNELS: BEGINNING JANUARY 3

Beginning the week of January 3, for approximately two months, crews are scheduled to install underground stone columns north of the Main Post Tunnels to stabilize the soil for seismic safety. Large rigs with vibrating columns will inject rock into the ground, creating three-foot-diameter, 50-foot-deep foundations of compacted material in approximately 3,500 locations.

This activity is part of site preparation for the future bluff that will connect the Main Post tunnel tops to Mason Street and facilitate the Presidio Tunnel Tops project. The stone columns will help prevent settlement or liquefaction during a seismic event.

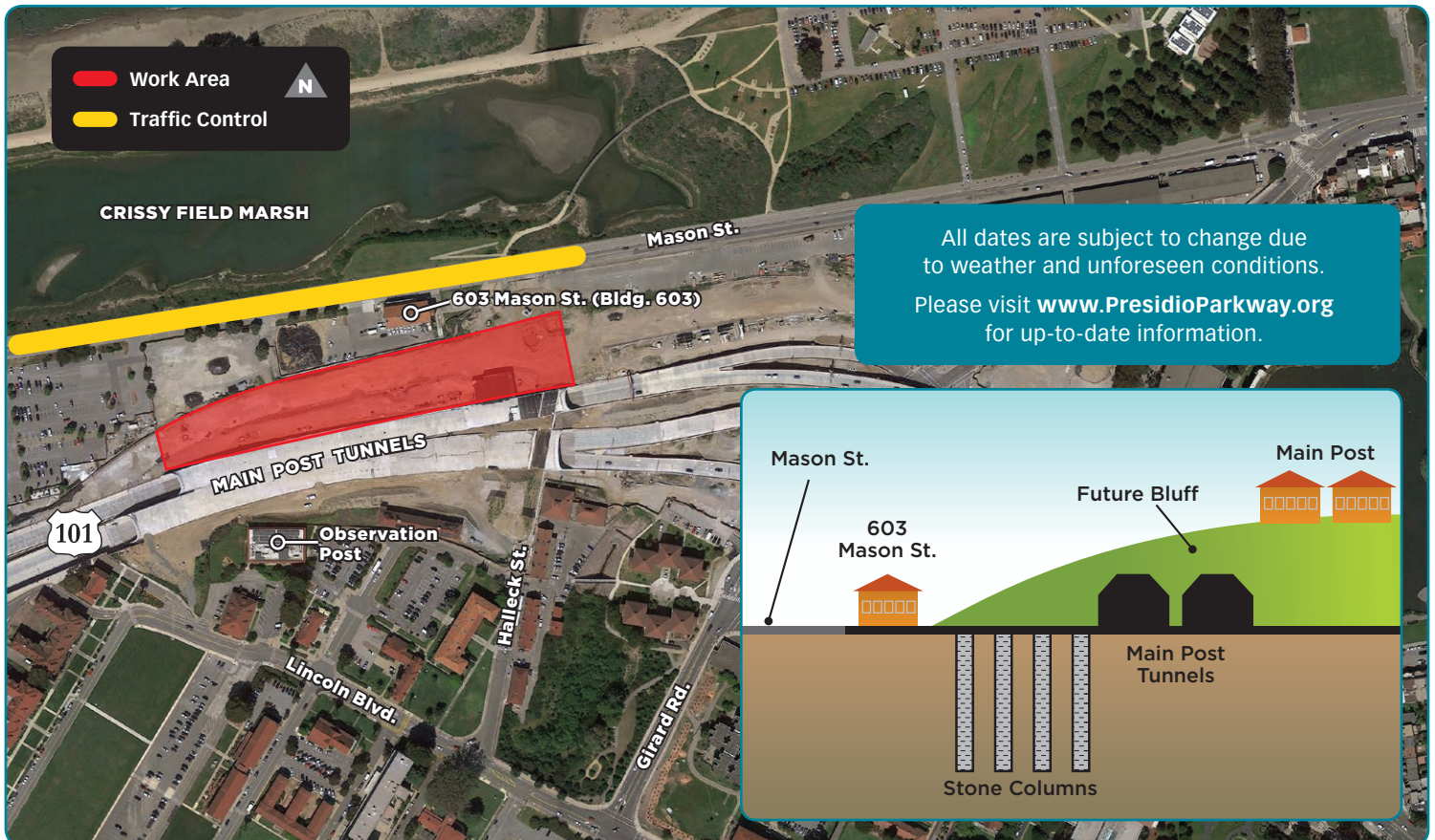
Beginning Tuesday, December 27, cranes and trucks will begin mobilizing to prepare for work to begin on January 3. Day and night work is scheduled for Monday

through Saturday. Crews will perform one shift per day, increasing to double shifts about one week into the operation to complete the installation as quickly as possible.

This work will require a high volume of truck traffic for material delivery at Mason Street. Noise impacts are expected primarily north of the work site. This work will also impact the Observation Post viewshed.

There will be traffic control along Mason Street during the entire operation. Drivers can expect intermittent delays. Please exercise caution around large equipment and follow instructions from signage and flaggers.
